  - a. **Meaning:** a thing belonging to someone, especially a house.
  - b. Spanish: propiedad

  - a. Meaning: successfully reach a desired result
  - b. Spanish: lograr

  - a. **Meaning:** happening or being used or done at the present time
  - b. **Spanish**: actual

  - a. **Meaning:** contain as part of a whole.
  - b. **Spanish**: incluir

  - a. Meaning: recurring at uniform intervals
  - b. **Spanish**: regular

  - a. **Meaning:** associated with the place of a person's birth.
